CultureKids focuses on teaching a foundation vocabulary base. Vocabulary repetition is vital to the learning process! Words are introduced weekly in a multisensory approach with games and song to engrain the vocabulary into memory. **New and returning students are invited to join!** Students at an elementary level build familiarity and confidence with this vocabulary. Each week students are given a take-home sheet to continue reinforcing the vocabulary and share with their family. Similar to learning English, students develop a base vocabulary and then begin compounding words to eventually form simple sentences.

New vocabulary and activities are introduced with each 6-week session allowing returning students to continue expanding their vocabulary base and new students to begin building their vocabulary base - classes are never a repeat!
